

**Cornville Community Association
Board Meeting

The regular Board Meeting of the Cornville Community Association was held at 6:00pm, Monday, June 16, 2008, at the Cornville Fire Station in Cornville, Arizona. They are also using misleading photographs to promote the sale of their lots. Efforts to resolve these issues have been met with resistance, and further official actions may be necessary.

Page Springs Road Historical Status Meeting: All are encouraged to come to the final disposition meeting for the Historical Status of Page Springs Road. The state committee responsible for the decision will meet with the public at the Cornville Fire Station Wednesday, June 18, 2008 at 1:30pm.
