The regular Board Meeting of the Cornville Community Association was held at 6:00pm, Monday, October 13, 2008, at the Cornville Fire Station in Cornville, Arizona. Board members present were Deanna King, Ted Luke, Dave Belkiewitz, Paul Graham, Russ Bottjer, and Jan Tomlinson. Board members Lois Hook and George Dana were absent.

Treasurer's Report: Ted Luke reported we collected \$67.00 for Bev Dana's memorial service, so the CCA also contributed \$67.00 for a total donation of \$134.00 to be forwarded to George Dana. Ending balance is \$2803.93. Local tax note: On a recent shopping trip to Wal-Mart in Cottonwood, it was calculated a shopper paid 10.275% sales tax including a 2.2% sales tax on food items.

Membership Report: Russ Bottjer reported the CCA currently has 223 members—an increase of one over last month. The Board has been unsuccessful in locating a copy of its last brochure, so a new one was made and offered to the Board for consideration. The Board did not vote, but gave approval for printing.

November Pot-Luck General Meeting Raffle: Twelve entrants have entered the chili cook-off contest. Contestants will be asked to list the major ingredients for those with sensitivities. The CCA will provide silverware, plates, bowls, water, buns, and napkins. Attendees are asked to bring salads, cornbread, deserts, chips, and appetizer plates.
