

CORNVILLE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION BOARD MINUTES

JANUARY 18, 2010

Meeting was called to order by Deanna at 6pm. All board members were present minus Geoff King.

General meeting minutes were approved and Ted Luke gave a budget update. We now have \$2208.18 in our budget.

Debbie Segal gave membership update. After last weeks meeting we now have 177 members. At last weeks meeting we had 36 members and 17 guests in attendance.

Lois gave update on Easter Egg hunt for April. She is good with toys, and eggs, will wait to buy candy until closer to date. She has been talking to business about the birthday party in July. We will also ask for volunteers to run for Board positions for 2010- 1012. George has filled his last term after 6 years. Paul, Lois and Jan's terms are up but volunteered to run again. A motion was made by George and seconded by Nikki to invite the businesses to attend in March. Deanna will contact the businesses to attend. She will not be at March meeting, will be Kauai. George will take over for that meeting.

Debbi asked about setting up a web link to our local businesses on our web site. Will discuss with Lisa to see if it is possible. This would be instead of doing another business directory. It was also discussed about getting the web page updated with new committee members and contact information,. Deanna and George will work together to get P&Z information to Lisa.

Paul brought up trails and said we are at stand still right now. No new meetings set up with County, and nothing heard from Mike Willett or Forest Service. Will try and get a meeting with County and Forest Service to get updates on Cornville trails.
