COMMUNITY MEETING MINUTES

JANUARY 13, 2010

The meeting was opened at 7:03 PM by President Deanna King with a Call to Order, followed by a welcome to the Community for attending and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ted Luke then gave the Treasurers report: Opening Balance \$2776.34, debits of \$1339.90, credits of \$460.43, and a final balance of \$1896.87.

Membership Chair Debbi Segall then stated that in 2009 the membership goal was almost reached with 245 members. This year 2010 there are 148 members paid, with four new business, 15 new members and 44 new renewals from previous years.

Deanna then explained that the Board had received a resignation from Dave Belkiewitz and introduced Nikki Lewis as the new Board member to take his place. And thanked her for her participation as the new Chair of the Planning and Zoning Committee.

Community Pride Chair Lois Hook was absent, but Deanna explained that the Easter Egg Hunt was still on and she will be looking for donations and volunteers for the annual event. 2010 is also the year of Cornville's 125<sup>th</sup> Birthday and Lois is planning for a large celebration so get ready to participate in the fun and excitement.

Next came a presentation to Tom O'Halleran from Jan Albright, President of the Verde River Citizen's Alliance for their Civic Award.

Then Deanna announced the clean up of Cornville Road would be January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010, which is a Saturday, and everyone should meet at Windmill Park at 8:00 AM.
