Community Meeting Minutes, January 9, 2008

The Cornville Community Association Meeting was held Wednesday, January 9, 2008 from 7:00 to 9:00 pm at the Oak Creek Elementary School Gym, 11490 E. Purple Sage Road, Cornville, AZ 86325. Board members present were, Deanna King, George Dana, Ted Luke, Paul Graham, Jan Tomlinson, and Craig Martinsen. Absent were Lois Hook, Pam Irvin, Lynne Ordean. There were 44 members present.

Deanna King called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone back after the holidays, provided guidelines followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes from the October, 2007 meeting.

Treasures report was given by Ted Luke- balance of \$2602.14 after expenses of mailing December news letter and bulk mail fee.

Membership by Craig Martinsen who reported 152 members as of date.

Planning and Zoning report was given by interim chairman, George Dana. He reported on 3 action items by the committee submitted by the County. He discussed a structure for the committee and recruiting of new members. Next meeting will be February 6.

Paul Graham gave an update on the Cornville Community Trails committee. They are now meeting again after five months of no activity. They are meeting on January 22 with Bill Stafford from the Forest Service to review open trails. He is also attending a Verde Valley Trails meeting on January 24.

Karen Taylor was the guest speaker. She had a slide presentation on using greywater, rain water and irrigation for plants, trees, gardens. She told how to work your plants and trees to get the most use of the sun in the winter and shade in the summer to cut down on utility bills. Plant in basins and use lots of mulch to use the water efficiently. Using greywater from your washing machine is the best use of water from your house to your garden. Using terra cotta pots in your gardens also is the best to use in watering.

Russ Bottjer gave an update on the Adopt-a-Highway program. He is looking for a few people to join his committee. They will be looking at different locations within the Cornville area for the Association to adopt. The goals: select a section of road set up a clean up schedule and learn the safety procedures. He will present to the Board for approval and then the members of the Association.

Deanna talked about upcoming meetings, asked for suggestions for future meetings.
