MINUTES, AUGUST 11, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Pres. Deanna King at 7 PM. Pledge of allegiance followed. Board members present were, Deanna King, Ted Luke, Lois Hook, Paul Graham, Gregg Law.

Ted Luke gave Treasurer's report with a beginning balance of \$3807.12, debits \$645.74, credits of \$677.66 for an ending balance of \$3839.04. Lois Hook thanked everyone for helping make the 125th birthday party a success. The next community pride event will be a potluck in November. Suggestions are appreciated.

Connie Dedrick, board member of the Boys and Girls Club and Hayley Bruemmer, Executive Director, explained the program they provide for kids. This group often supplies the adult role models that kids need along with healthy food and nutrition as well as physical activities. They are having a Fall Harvest fundraiser event at a ranch on Page Springs Rd. Oct. 16 11-5 PM. A video showed many of the activities provided. The Club hopes to be in Cornville in 3-5 years, and is looking for sponsors. You can help with a donation of \$39 a month to help these kids.

Verde Valley Fire Chief Doerksen introduced a crew to demonstrate the new "evacusplint." They are always finding ways to keep the patient comfortable during rescues. He also explained the budget in PowerPoint, and how they are attempting to bring down the part of our tax bill that funds the fire district, while continuing to improve service. One future project is a station in Verde Santa Fe. CPR instructor Skip Heyer demonstrated CCR and AED, and encouraged people to attend upcoming open houses at 2 fire stations. Training will be provided there. Arizona leads in this area. There will be a car wash on Sat. August 14 at the station on 260 and Goddard from 8-12pm to raise money for car seats and bike helmets.
