

MINUTES OF CORNVILLE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, JANUARY 12, 2011

President Deanna King opened the meeting at 7 PM with flag salute. There were approximately 43 persons present. Treasurer Ted Luke reported a \$1524.23 balance after our mass mailing to Cornville households. He noted that he saw several thrown away at the post office. Lois Hook was absent, so Deanna reported a summary of Community Pride events for 2010. Nikki Lewis reported on some items that have come before the P&Z. Debbi Segall reported year end numbers at 280 and for 2011 so far we have 103 members for new year.

The next Cornville Rd. Cleanup will take place on Jan 29 at 9 AM. Russ Bottjer is in charge, and asks that we meet him at Windmill Park. Deanna reported that the ditch at Windmill Park is emptied and shut down for a month for maintenance. Also, there will be an upcoming Dump the Drugs day to dispose of outdated drugs properly. Deanna also discussed the Pink Heals tour coming to the Verde Valley in August. Cottonwood Fire Dept. will holding an event, as well as Cornville. They are looking at Sedona and or Camp Verde and it will end the event in Jerome. Watch for fliers and information regarding fund raisers. Will work with Verde Valley Fire Dept. also.

Guest speaker Pam Pearsall, County Assessor explained how property taxes work in Arizona. If county budgets stay the same, property taxes do not go down even if house values go down. There is an 18 month lag before taxes reflect the assessment card we get in Feb.-Mar. She explained the vocabulary on property taxes and answered many questions from the audience.
